Add language that approval of alley closure is contingent upon Council approval of rezoning bill 2024-152

- Closure requested to allow for a mixed-use development on the adjacent parcel
- Waives Council Rule 3.107 to allow for reintroduction of legislation within twelve months of denial
- Waiver requested because the alley closure is associated with a modified rezoning application being considered by the Council as a result of a settlement agreement related to the proposed Southbank self storage development

Public Hearing:

There were no speakers.

Edward Linsky of the Council Auditor's Office explained the amendment, which made the approval of this bill contingent upon the passage of the associated Planned Unit Development bill.

Council Member Carlucci stated that he was not in favor of approving a \$6 million loan to the developer for the affordable housing portion of the project before the approval of the associated PUD bill.

Council Member Clark-Murray noted that Committee needed to be objective in the passage of this bill, explaining the legal requirements for the City's abandoning of this alley. Council Member Carlucci explained that he had mixed up the bill associated with the alley closure and the bill associated with the affordable housing loan, given that they both had the same amendment (to make their approval contingent upon the passage of the associated PUD bill) attached to them. He asked whether the amendments for these two bills used the same language, and Mary Staffopoulos of the Office of the General Counsel explained that they did.

The amendment was unanimously approved by the Committee.

Public Comment:

Carnell Oliver spoke on bill 2024-0289, stating that it should be a goal of the City to invest in infrastructure projects in majority-black neighborhoods. He explained that many people in these neighborhoods do not feel as though the current administration is working for them. He recommended creating a rental assistance program for black renters specifically and noted that there were many unspent federal funds received through COVID stimulus bills that could be used to fund such a project.
