FlexCold, LLC and their real estate arm, 11180 Blasius Road, LLC, an international distributor of frozen protein proposed to construct a 150,000 square foot processing and distribution facility in north Jacksonville, at 11180 Blasius Road, and were awarded a \$1,100,000 REV Grant responsible for the creation of 20 new full-time jobs at an average wage of \$51,192 pursuant to Resolution 2021-187-A. To keep up with market demands the Company proposes to add an additional 196,000 square foot expansion
for a total of 346,000 square feet.
The company is also considering locating the proposed expansion facility in other port cities along the eastern U.S. seaboard. If Jacksonville is selected, they propose to create a total of 40 new jobs at an average wage of \$55,422 plus benefits no later than December 31, 2025. FlexCold has stated that the City of Jacksonville's proposed financial incentive is a material factor in their decision to expand and further develop their logistics, warehouse, and distribution center in Jacksonville.
To support their expansion the City is proposing to consolidate the two phases into one overall agreement to provide 5-year REV Grant, at 50%, based on the consolidated project, increasing their total capital investment from \$47 million up to \$115 million, and the creation of 40 new jobs, by the end of 2025. The REV Grant would be capped at \$2,500,000.
