ORDINANCE 2023-436-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,077,047.72 FROM BUILDING INSPECTION FUND BALANCE TO THE ED BALL HEARING ROOM AND RESTROOM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (THE "PROJECT") FOR COMPLETION OF PHASE TWO OF THE PROJECT, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 23-104; PROVIDING FOR REVERTER OF FUNDS; AMENDING THE 2023-2027 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2022-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of funds from Building Inspection Fund fund balance to the Ed Ball Hearing Room and Restroom Improvements Project (the "Project") for completion of phase two of the Project.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to pay costs to complete construction of phase two of the Project which entails improvements to the first-floor hearing room in the Ed Ball Building. These improvements will allow various City boards and commissions, including the Planning Commission, the Historic Preservation Commission, the Municipal Code Compliance Division, Special Magistrate, and the Building Code Adjustment Board, to use this space for public meetings and hearings. The hearing room will also be used as a training room when not otherwise in use.

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Section 3. Reverter. Any funds remaining after completion of the Project shall be returned to the account of origin.

Section 4. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the Project in fiscal year 2022-2023 as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of the Project and utilization of the new hearing room by various City boards and commissions.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become

effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 1 without the Mayor's signature. 2 3 Form Approved: 4 5 6
