6 AMOUNT OF \$814,375.00 FROM THE FLORIDA

8 PRE-PAID WIRELESS NEXT GENERATION 911 (NG911)
9 STATE GRANT PROGRAM, TO THE JACKSONVILLE
10 SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO IMPLEMENT THE NEXT
11 GENERATION 911 (NG-911) ROUTING PROJECT, AS
12 INITIATED BY B.T. 23-050; PROVIDING FOR
13 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE;
14 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,
18 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)

27 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

28 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
29 funds from the Florida Department of Management Services,
30 through its Pre-paid Wireless Next Generation 911 (NG911)
31 State Grant Program, to the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office

1 to implement the Next Generation 911 (NG-911) Routing
2 project (the "Project"). The grant period commenced on
3 January 19, 2023 and ends on March 24, 2028. No local
4 match is required.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
6 Section 1 is to utilize grant funding from the Florida Department of
7 Management Services to implement the Project. The funds will be used
8 for hardware and software licenses and support for the cloud-based
9 Region 3 GIS Repository. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office has
10 negotiated the with a current vendor, Datamark, to provide the
11 requisite services for this cloud-based system as part of an existing
12 GSA Federal Acquisition Services contract (47QRAA21D008D). Copies
13 of the Grant Award letter, the Datamark Proposal for Duval County,
14 Florida, dated September 26, 2022, providing the scope of services
15 and budget for Datamark's provision of services relative to the
16 Project, and the Additional Terms and Conditions for Rural and State
17 Grant S22-23-01-19 (Grant Agreement) providing the terms and
18 conditions for the grant and use of the grant funds are **On File** in
19 the Legislative Services Division.

20 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
21 shall oversee administration of the grant and project described
22 herein.

23 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
24 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
25 without the Mayor's signature.
