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23 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

24 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2026-2027 fiscal year,
25 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of Opioid Special Revenue Trust Fund funding to the University of Florida Board of Trustees.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to utilize the funding from the Opioid Special Revenue Trust Fund to directly support the University of Florida College of Medicine Jacksonville's Thrive Together - Multidisciplinary Support for OUD Recovery Program.

Section 3. Oversight. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department's Office of Opioid Abatement shall oversee administration of the funding described herein.

Section 4. Approval and Authorization to Execute Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City a grant agreement, including amendments thereto, with the University of Florida Board of Trustees in an amount not to exceed \$499,576.00, subject to the terms sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, for a term commencing October 1, 2026 and continuing through September 30, 2027, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, *Ordinance Code*.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
