**Bill Summary:** The bill grants a non-residential solid waste collection and transportation certificate of public convenience and necessity (CON) to Five Talent Services, LLC d/b/a Mobiledumps of Jacksonville. The Solid Waste Division is designated as the City's oversight agency for the CON.

**Background Information:** The franchise permits to company to collect and transport solid waste within the City of Jacksonville, excluding the Beaches cities and Town of Baldwin for an indefinite period of time, as long as the company complies with all applicable City regulations. The company will operate a service that delivers a 14-foot dumping trailer to customer sites and returns to haul the construction or household waste away when full for disposal in a licensed landfill.

Policy Impact Area: Solid waste regulation

**Fiscal Impact:** Five Talent Services has paid the application fee of \$1,500 and will pay a monthly franchise fee equal to 17% of gross revenues.
