AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$70,000 FROM A DESIGNATED CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO THE HUMAN COLLECTIVE FOUNDATION, INC. ("HCF"), FOR THE HUMAN COLLECTIVE AWARENESS PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM") DESCRIBED HEREIN; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH HCF; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH HCF; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE HUMAN COLLECTIVE FOUNDATION, INC. FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACTS COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$70,000 from a Designated Contingency account to the Subsidies and Contributions to Private Organizations account to provide funding to The Human Collective Foundation, Inc. ("HCF") for The Human Collective Awareness Program (the "Program") which will consist of hosting two events focused on social worker appreciation and mental health awareness as well as human trafficking awareness. Both events will be open to the public.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to HCF for the Program as described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program will entail hosting two events, which shall be open to the public, that are intended to raise awareness regarding mental health and human trafficking while also providing training and showing appreciation for social workers placed in Duval County schools.

The first event will entail providing workshops and training opportunities for social workers and mental health professionals

working with youth in Duval County, to provide additional skills needed to address the mental health challenges students face. This event is intended to show both an appreciation for these professionals while also fostering a network of collaboration and an opportunity to share best practices. The second event will be a human trafficking awareness event. This event will focus on raising awareness of human trafficking, including educating the attendees on recognizing the signs of human trafficking and the necessary steps to prevent it. Various anti-human trafficking organizations will be present to assist in providing this educational opportunity.

Section 3. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure the professional services of The Human Collective Foundation, Inc. to administer the Program described herein. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code. Such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with The Human Collective Foundation, Inc. HCF works both domestically and internationally with a variety of service providers, who have a common goal of raising awareness regarding mental health and human trafficking, while also focusing on the needs of social workers in the school system. HCF is able to use these important connections to reach a broader audience through the

above-described events, which allows for a greater impact on the Jacksonville community.

Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City an agreement with The Human Collective Foundation, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$70,000, subject to the Scope of Services and Budget more particularly described in Exhibit 2, for a term commencing upon the City's execution of the agreement through September 30, 2024, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

Section 6. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance and Administration Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
