5 AN ORDINANCE WAIVING SECTIONS 260.201
6 (LICENSE), 260.206 (TEMPORARY STORAGE OF WASTE
7 TIRES), AND 260.208 (HOURS OF OPERATION) OF
8 PART 2 (LICENSING AND TRANSPORTING
9 REQUIREMENTS; REVOCATION OF LICENSE) OF
10 CHAPTER 260 (DISPOSAL OF WASTE TIRES),
11 *ORDINANCE CODE*, FROM SEPTEMBER 14, 2019,
12 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 28, 2019, IN SUPPORT OF THE
13 SIXTH ANNUAL WASTE TIRE AND SNIPE SIGN BUYBACK
14 EVENT SO AS TO 1) ALLOW DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENTS
15 TO TRANSPORT MORE THAN EIGHT (8) WASTE TIRES,
16 2) ALLOW FOR THE TEMPORARY STORAGE OF TIRES,
17 3) SUSPEND THE REQUIREMENT THAT AN INDIVIDUAL
18 BE LICENSED IN ORDER TO HAUL MORE THAN EIGHT
19 (8) WASTE TIRES, AND 4) ALLOW FOR
20 TRANSPORTATION OF WASTE TIRES OUTSIDE OF
21 MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY 7:00 A.M.- 6:00 P.M.;
22 PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT
23 OF PUBLIC WORKS; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE
24 EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
25 DATE.

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27 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

28 **Section 1. Waiver of Sections of Chapter 260, Part 2,**
29 **Ordinance Code.** Sections 260.201 (License), 260.206 (Temporary
30 storage of waste tires), and 260.208 (Hours of operation) of Part 2
31 (Licensing and Transporting Requirements; Revocation of License) of

1 Chapter 260 (Disposal of Waste Tires), *Ordinance Code*, are hereby
2 waived for the 2019 Waste Tire and Snipe Sign buyback event from
3 September 14, 2019, to September 28, 2019, the event day, so as to:
4 (1) allow Duval County residents to transport more than eight (8)
5 waste tires; (2) allow for the temporary storage of tires; (3)
6 suspend the requirement that an individual be licensed in order to
7 haul more than eight (8) waste tires; and, (4) allow for the
8 transportation of waste tires outside of Monday through Saturday
9 7:00 a.m.- 6:00 p.m.

10 **Section 2. Oversight Department.** The Department of
11 Public Works shall oversee the event described herein. For each and
12 every year the Council approves the fiscal year budget where funds
13 are appropriated to hold the annual Waste Tire and Snipe Sign
14 Buyback Event, the Director of Public Works shall have the
15 authority to waive the specific sections of Chapter 260, Part 2
16 referenced herein by submitting in writing to the Council President
17 at least forty-five (45) calendar days in advance of the event, the
18 dates and times of the event, the location of the event, the dates
19 of the waiver, and the specific portions of Chapter 260, Part 2
20 referenced herein that are waived.

21 **Section 3. Requesting one cycle emergency passage**
22 **pursuant to Council Rules 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency
23 passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the
24 emergency is that scheduling conflicts for other events at Lot J
25 and adjacent City venues (actual booked events and tentative holds)
26 did not allow a sufficient time period from Friday to Sunday to set
27 up, take down, and hold the event until later in the fiscal year
28 when Lot J became available.

29 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
30 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
31 without the Mayor's signature.
