7 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF  
8 AREZOU "ARI" JOLLY AS A MEMBER OF THE CULTURAL  
9 SERVICE GRANT PROGRAM COMMITTEE, AS ONE OF THE  
10 THREE BOARD MEMBERS, REPLACING JEFF STROHECKER,  
11 PURSUANT TO SECTION 118.605, *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR  
12 A PARTIAL TERM EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 2023;  
13 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to §118.605(a), *Ordinance Code*, the membership  
16 of the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee shall be comprised  
17 of 1 non-voting member and 10 voting members (3 Cultural Council  
18 Board Members and 7 individuals from the community appointed by the  
19 Cultural Council Board President, Cultural Service Grant Program  
20 Committee Chair, and the 3 Cultural Council Board Members); and

21 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to §118.605(d), *Ordinance Code*, all members  
22 of the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee shall be confirmed  
23 by the City Council; now therefore

24 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Confirmation.** The Council hereby confirms the  
26 appointment of Arezou "Ari" Jolly, a Duval County resident, to the  
27 Cultural Service Grant Program Committee, as one of the three board  
28 members, replacing Jeff Strohecker, pursuant to §118.605, *Ordinance*  
29 *Code*, for a partial term ending December 31, 2023.

30 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become  
31 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
