EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING

AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, born and raised in Duval County, Sherrod T. Brown is a proud native of Jacksonville, and he has dedicated his life to excellence in the performing arts, carrying with him the values, spirit, and cultural richness of his hometown; and

WHEREAS, Jacksonville shaped Sherrod T. Brown's early foundation as an artist, providing him with encouragement, education, and formative opportunities that ignited his lifelong journey in music, dance, theatre, and creative expression; and

WHEREAS, Sherrod T. Brown's celebrated career spans Broadway, national touring productions, and major entertainment platforms, beginning with his standout debut in *Jesus Christ Superstar* as Judas/Simon Zealotes, where his talent and presence captured national attention; and

WHEREAS, Sherrod T. Brown further represented Jacksonville's vibrancy and athletic artistry as a professional dancer for the NBA's Orlando Magic, showcasing his triple-threat abilities on one of the nation's most visible sports stages; and

WHEREAS, Sherrod T. Brown achieved international distinction when he was personally selected by Oscar nominee Hugh Jackman to perform as a featured soloist in Hugh Jackman's residency show, "Hugh Jackman: From New York, With Love," at Radio City Music Hall from

January through October of 2025, performing songs like "Never Enough," an extraordinary honor on one of the world's most iconic stages and reached tens of thousands nationwide; and

WHEREAS, Sherrod T. Brown continues to elevate Jacksonville's artistic identity as a cast member of the 2026 Broadway Company of Cats, one of the most beloved and enduring musicals in theatrical history; and

WHEREAS, beyond performance, Sherrod T. Brown actively enriches the cultural ecosystem by developing innovative artistic pathways, including orchestral projects such as *The Singer-Songwriter Suite*, which merges Broadway, classical traditions, and popular music, bridging communities and expanding artistic visibility for future generations; and

WHEREAS, Sherrod T. Brown has brought significant honor to the City of Jacksonville through his commitment to representing his hometown with excellence, integrity, and civic pride, serving as a role model for aspiring artists and a testament to the power of homegrown talent; now therefore
