ORDINANCE 2025-459

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND RATIFYING, AND AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL COUNSEL, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES OFFICE OF INSPECTOR GENERAL, PROVIDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE CITY'S REIMBURSEMENT OF OVERPAYMENTS MADE TO THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT ("JFRD") FOR CERTAIN AMBULANCE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES RENDERED BY JFRD BETWEEN DECEMBER 1, 2022 AND JANUARY 31, 2023, INCLUDING RESTITUTION AND PENALTIES IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT \$154,654.79; AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL OF COUNSEL, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO TAKE FURTHER ACTION AS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AUTHORIZED HEREIN; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, for the period of December 1, 2022 through January 31, 2023, the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department ("JFRD") mistakenly presented invoices to Medicare, the Florida Medicaid program, Tricare, and the Veteran's Administration (collectively "the Federal Government") for services that were provided by several JFRD Paramedics and Emergency Medical Technicians whose licenses had recently expired; and

WHEREAS, payments were made to JFRD for these services by the Federal Government resulting in overpayment to the City of Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville desires to correct the overpayments made by entering into a Settlement Agreement with the United States Department of Health and Human Services Office of Inspector General ("OIG") in the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1, which includes restitution and payment of a penalty, and resolves the City of Jacksonville's liability to the Federal Government for the improper claims and overpayments made; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of this settlement is \$167,111.31, including overpayments to the City in the amount of \$111,407.54 and a penalty of \$55,703.77; and

WHEREAS, the City has already repaid \$12,456.52 of the overpayment, leaving \$98,951.02 due to be repaid; and

WHEREAS, the total remaining settlement balance to be paid to the OIG is \$154,654.79 (including the remaining repayment balance of \$98,951.02 plus a penalty of \$55,703.77), and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City and the public that the Federal Government's claim be resolved without resorting to litigation and related costs and expenses; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Agreement. The City Council hereby approves and ratifies the Settlement Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the United States Department of Health and Human Services Office of Inspector General in the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein. The General Counsel, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Settlement Agreement.

Section 2. Further Action Authorized. The General Counsel, or his designee, is hereby authorized to take such further action and to execute all other documents necessary to effectuate the approved and ratified Settlement Agreement.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
