AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$134,615.00 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF LOCATIVE TRACKING DEVICES AND RELATED SUPPLIES, INITIATED BY B.T. 24-034; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT ΒY THE JACKSONVILLE'S SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

> The funding above represents an appropriation of grant funds in the amount of \$134,615.00 from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, through its BJA FY 23 The Kevin and Avonte Program: Reducing Injury and Death of Missing

Individuals with Dementia and Developmental Disabilities to the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to fund the purchase of the locative tracking devices and related supplies for the purpose of expanding an existing tracking program by increasing the number of tracking devices from 20 to 220 devices. No local match is required. The grant period is from October 1, 2023 and continues through September 30, 2026.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund the purchase of locative tracking devices to expand an existing locative tracking program from 20 to 220 devices. This will allow the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to more aptly serve the City's population. This project will provide locative tracking devices at no cost to voluntary participants and serve individuals of any age who have forms of dementia or a developmental disability and are prone to wander from safe environments.

A copy of the Grant Award Letter (Award Number 15PBJA-23-GG-04243-MAPX) outlining the terms and conditions and uses of the grant funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Oversight Department. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office shall oversee administration of the grant described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
