6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$134,615.00 IN GRANT
7 FUNDING FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
8 JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, BUREAU OF
9 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF
10 LOCATIVE TRACKING DEVICES AND RELATED SUPPLIES,
11 AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-034; PROVIDING FOR
12 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE'S SHERIFF'S
13 OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
17 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
18 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
19 listed in subsection (b):

27 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
28 funds in the amount of \$134,615.00 from the United States
29 Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau
30 of Justice Assistance, through its BJA FY 23 The Kevin and
31 Avonte Program: Reducing Injury and Death of Missing

1 Individuals with Dementia and Developmental Disabilities
2 to the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to fund the purchase
3 of the locative tracking devices and related supplies for
4 the purpose of expanding an existing tracking program by
5 increasing the number of tracking devices from 20 to 220
6 devices. No local match is required. The grant period is
7 from October 1, 2023 and continues through September 30,
8 2026.

9 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
10 Section 1 is to fund the purchase of locative tracking devices to
11 expand an existing locative tracking program from 20 to 220 devices.
12 This will allow the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office to more aptly serve
13 the City's population. This project will provide locative tracking
14 devices at no cost to voluntary participants and serve individuals
15 of any age who have forms of dementia or a developmental disability
16 and are prone to wander from safe environments.

17 A copy of the Grant Award Letter (Award Number
18 15PBJA-23-GG-04243-MAPX) outlining the terms and conditions and uses
19 of the grant funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated
20 herein by this reference.

21 **Section 3. Oversight Department.** The Jacksonville
22 Sheriff's Office shall oversee administration of the grant described
23 herein.

24 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
25 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
26 without the Mayor's signature.
