ORDINANCE 2025-187-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$108,886 FROM THE RENEW ARLINGTON CRA TRUST FUND - PROPERTY TAXES ACCOUNT TO THE CRAOED ANNUAL ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES ACTIVITY TO PROVIDE \$63,595 TO PAY THE SALARY AND RELATED COSTS TO HIRE ONE (1) PART-TIME PROFESSIONAL LANDSCAPE DESIGNER AND TO ALLOCATE \$45,291 TO THE UNALLOCATED PLAN AUTHORIZED EXPENDITURES ACCOUNT FOR FUTURE ALLOCATION BY THE RENEW ARLINGTON COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY ("CRA") BOARD; APPROVING PART-TIME HOURS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is an appropriation of \$108,886 in additional ad valorem revenue received in fiscal year 2024-2025 from the Renew Arlington CRA Trust Fund -

Property Taxes account to the CRAOED Annual Administrative Expenses Activity to provide \$63,595 to pay the salary and related costs to hire one (1) part-time professional landscape designer to support the Mandatory Compliance Grant Program and to allocate \$45,291 to the Unallocated Plan Authorized Expenditures account for future allocation by the Renew Arlington Community Redevelopment Agency ("CRA") Board.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide \$63,595 to the Renew Arlington CRA to hire one (1) additional part-time professional landscape designer to support the Mandatory Compliance Grant Program ("MCGP"). The MCGP was created to offer assistance to property owners/applicants to come into compliance with fencing, sign and landscaping/landscape buffer requirements for non-residential properties located within the boundary of the CRA/Renew Arlington Zoning Overlay. The professional landscape designer would assist with application and design review for the MCGP. This funding will allow for up to 1,248 part-time hours for the position. In addition to the above, this appropriation includes allocating \$45,291 to the Unallocated Plan Authorized Expenditures account for future allocation by the Renew Arlington CRA Board for authorized expenditures. A copy of the Renew Arlington CRA Board Resolution in support of this appropriation is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Approval of Part-time Hours. There are hereby approved the part-time hours more fully described in **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
