6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$190,000.00 FROM  
7 THE MOSQUITO CONTROL STATE SUBFUND 00112 FUND  
8 BALANCE TO BE USED FOR MOSQUITO CONTROL  
9 DIVISION OPERATIONAL EXPENSES, INCLUDING THE  
10 PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES, DURING  
11 FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 AND TO LEVERAGE A  
12 REIMBURSEMENT GRANT FROM THE FLORIDA  
13 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO FUND ACTIVITIES  
14 DESIGNED TO COMBAT TROPICAL STORM-INDUCED  
15 MOSQUITO INFESTATIONS AND MOSQUITO-BORNE VIRUS  
16 OUTBREAKS, WITH NO LOCAL MATCH, AS INITIATED  
17 BY B.T. 21-060; PURPOSE OF THE APPROPRIATION;  
18 PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS; PROVIDING AN  
19 EFFECTIVE DATE.

21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal  
23 year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
24 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
25 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

1 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

2 The funding above comprises an appropriation of  
3 \$190,000.00 in fund balance from Mosquito Control State  
4 Subfund 00112 to supplement operational line items in the  
5 Mosquito Control Division General Funds budget for fiscal  
6 year (FY) 2020-2021 and to leverage a reimbursement grant  
7 from the Florida Department of Health to fund activities  
8 designed to combat tropical storm-induced mosquito  
9 infestations and mosquito-borne virus outbreaks, with no  
10 local match required.

11 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
12 Section 1 is to transfer \$190,000.00 from Mosquito Control State  
13 Subfund 00112 to cover operational expenses for the Mosquito  
14 Control Division during FY 2020-2021 including, but not limited to,  
15 the purchase of mosquito aerosol spray machines, mobile devices for  
16 field technicians, and biological-control products as well as  
17 replacement of perimeter fencing at the 12-acre facility located on  
18 Eastport Road. In addition, these funds will be used to leverage a  
19 time-limited reimbursement grant from the Florida Department of  
20 Health to assist the Mosquito Control Division with upgrading local  
21 capability to counteract tropical storm-induced mosquito  
22 infestations and mosquito-borne virus outbreaks. No local match is  
23 required.

24 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in this  
25 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2021-  
26 2022.

27 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
29 without the Mayor's signature.
