## ORDINANCE 2024-547-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORTION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN FOURTH AMENDED AND RESTATED FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND JACKSONVILLE TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY ("JTA") TO FURTHER EXPAND THE "DOOR-TO-STORE PROGRAM" APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2021-46-E, AS EXTENDED AND EXPANDED BY ORDINANCE 2021-140-E, ORDINANCE 2022-135-E, AND ORDINANCE 2023-760-E "PROGRAM"), A COMPONENT OF THE FULL-SERVICE GROCERY STORE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM ESTABLISHED UNDER ORDINANCE 2019-812-E; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT AND PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION BY OFFICE OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval and authorization for the Amended and Restated Funding Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, that certain Fourth Amended and Restated Funding Agreement (the "Agreement") between the City of Jacksonville and the Jacksonville Transportation Authority, attached hereto as  ${f Exhibit}$  1 and incorporated herein by

this reference. The purpose of the Agreement is to expand the "Door-To-Store Program", as approved by Ordinance 2021-46-E and previously extended and expanded by Ordinance 2021-140-E, Ordinance 2022-135-E, and Ordinance 2023-760-E, to allow for the inclusion of a new full-service grocery store and also permit the City and JTA to include additional full-service grocery stores within the Northwest Jacksonville Economic Development Fund boundary area in the future without Council approval.

Section 2. Oversight Department. The Office of Economic Development shall oversee and administer the Program described herein.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
