Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in

Section 1 is to provide additional funding for the Home Roof Initiative originally approved by Ordinance 2023-807-E. This Initiative was created based on recommendations from the Mayoral Transition Committees and a series of community conversations as one of several programs that could assist in addressing homelessness or homelessness prevention in Jacksonville. This Initiative provides funding in a maximum amount of up to \$14,999 to qualified households in Duval County in need of a roof replacement to avoid loss of insurance coverage.

Section 3. Oversight. The Neighborhoods Department, Housing and Community Development Division, shall have oversight of the project described herein.

to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that there are currently a large number of qualified households on a waiting list to receive assistance through this Initiative. This additional funding will allow the City to provide assistance to a greater number of households as quickly as possible, prior to the upcoming storm season.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
