2 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 3 Section 1 is to provide funds for OSUD Grants to be awarded to qualified requesting agencies in Fiscal Year 2024-2025 in accordance 4 5 with Chapter 84 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants), Ordinance Code. Section 84.301 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Allocation for Opioid 6 7 Settlement Proceeds Grants), Ordinance Code, requires that 70% of Opioid Settlement Proceeds deposited in the Opioid Settlement Special 8 9 Revenue Fund during the immediately preceding calendar year shall be 10 included in the Mayor's annual budget to fund OSUD Grants in the upcoming fiscal year. The funds appropriated herein comprise 70% of 11 the total interest collected on all Opioid Settlement Proceeds dollars 12 deposited in the Opioid Settlement Special Revenue Fund through 13 September 30, 2024. 14

15 Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 17 without the Mayor's signature.
