6 FUNDING FROM END HUMAN TRAFFICKING, INC. D/B/A
7 FLORIDA ALLIANCE TO END HUMAN TRAFFICKING
8 ("GRANTOR"), A NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION
9 CREATED PURSUANT TO SECTION 16.618, *FLORIDA*
10 *STATUTES*, FUNDED THROUGH ITS HUMAN TRAFFICKING
11 GRANT PROGRAM, TO THE PSBU GRANTS/HUMAN
12 TRAFFICKING GRANT PROGRAM FY24 TO PURCHASE
13 EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE TO COMBAT HUMAN
14 TRAFFICKING, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-082;
15 APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER
16 DESIGNEE, THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND THE
17 SHERIFF TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE
18 CITY THE GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND
19 GRANTOR; PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS
20 UNTIL JUNE 30, 2025; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY
21 THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN
22 EFFECTIVE DATE.
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24 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
26 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
27 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
28 listed in subsection (b):

4 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

5 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
6 funds from End Human Trafficking, Inc. d/b/a Florida
7 Alliance to End Human Trafficking, a not-for-profit
8 corporation created pursuant to Section 16.618, *Florida*
9 *Statutes* ("Grantor"), funded through its Human Trafficking
10 Grant Program to the PSBU Grants/Human Trafficking Grant
11 Program FY24 to purchase equipment and software to combat
12 human trafficking. The grant period commences on the date
13 of execution of the Grant Agreement and continues through
14 June 30, 2025. No local match is required.

15 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
16 Section 1 is to utilize private grant funding from Grantor to deploy
17 new technology and enhance existing technology to be used to
18 investigate human trafficking cases. A copy of the Grant Agreement
19 between the City and Grantor outlining the terms and conditions
20 relative to the grant and use of the grant funds is attached hereto
21 as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Grant
22 Agreement").

23 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization.** The Grant Agreement
24 is hereby approved and the Mayor, or her designee, the Corporation
25 Secretary and the Sheriff are hereby authorized to execute and deliver
26 on behalf of the City the Grant Agreement. The foregoing approval and
27 authorization is in addition to, and not a limitation on, all
28 authorizations set forth in Chapter 117 (Grants), *Ordinance Code*.

29 **Section 4. Carryover** The funds appropriated in Section 1
30 of this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover until June 30,
31 2025.

1 **Section 5. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
2 shall oversee administration of the grant and project described
3 herein.

4 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
5 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6 without the Mayor's signature.
