AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000.00 FROM A COUNCIL OPERATING CONTINGENCY TO THE WOMEN'S CENTER OF JACKSONVILLE, INC. TO BE USED FOR AN ADVERTISING CAMPAIGN TO COMBAT SEXUAL ASSAULT; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT BY THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE AND CORPORATION SECRETARY; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION TO SECTION 126.107(G), ORDINANCE CODE, IN ORDER TO DIRECT CONTRACT WITH THE WOMEN'S CENTER OF INC.; JACKSONVILLE, PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE SOCIAL SERVICES DIVISION THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE **EMERGENCY** PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: **Section 1.** Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

appropriated from the designated City Council Operating Contingency to the Women's Center of Jacksonville, Inc. to create and distribute sexual assault prevention posters and other materials; the advertising campaign is meant to correspond with Spring Break for high schools and colleges and materials would be distributed at restaurants, bars and hotels in Jacksonville Beach, Neptune Beach and Atlantic Beach.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide \$10,000.00 in funding to the Women's Center of Jacksonville, Inc. to be used to create and distribute information for a public service announcement/campaign aimed at combatting sexual assault. Of the total expended by the Women's Center of Jacksonville, Inc., up to 15% of the funding may be used for labor costs associated with design and production of the informational materials and posters and any promotional activities associated with the public service campaign. The advertising campaign is meant to correspond with Spring Break for high schools and colleges and posters, flyers and information packets will be distributed at local restaurants, bars and hotels in Jacksonville Beach, Neptune Beach and Atlantic Beach.

Section 3. Authorizing the Mayor and Corporation Secretary to Execute Contract with the Women's Center of Jacksonville, Inc. The Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are authorized to execute a contract with the Women's Center of Jacksonville, Inc. for contribution of \$10,000, substantially the same form as contained in Revised Exhibit 2,

Invoking the exception pursuant to Section Section 4. 126.107(q), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with the Women's Center of Jacksonville, Inc. to provide funding to the Women's Center of Jacksonville, Inc. to be used for a contribution of \$10,000 toward a public service campaign aimed at combatting sexual assault and rape. The posters and other informational materials would correspond with Spring Break for high schools and colleges and posters, flyers and information packets will be distributed at local restaurants, bars and hotels in Jacksonville Beach, Neptune Beach and Atlantic Beach. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Oversight Department. The Parks, Recreation Section 5. and Community Services Department, Social Services Division, shall oversee the project described herein.

Requesting Cycle Emergency Section 6. One Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the public service campaign is directed to students and young adults who may be visiting Jacksonville and the area beaches during Spring Break, which occurs in March. In order to get the materials created and distributed prior to various schools' Spring Break schedules, it is necessary to have the funds available by March 2, 2020.

Section 7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
