**ORDINANCE 2025-181-E**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$24,200.00 FROM THE CONTRIBUTIONS FROM PRIVATE SOURCES ACCOUNT TO THE OTHER PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ACCOUNT WITHIN THE ART IN PUBLIC PLACES TRUST FUND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF ARTWORK LOCATED IN THE LIFT EV'RY VOICE AND SING PARK, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 25-056; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE CULTURAL COUNCIL OF GREATER JACKSONVILLE, INC.; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation - Appropriating funding in the amount of \$24,200.00 from the Contributions From

Private Sources account to the Other Professional Services account within the Art in Public Places Trust Fund for maintenance costs associated with the artwork entitled "Calling it Done" located in Lift Ev'ry Voice and Sing Park (the "Public Art"). The funds appropriated herein shall be disbursed at the request of the Cultural Council of Greater Jacksonville, Inc.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 above is to allocate the \$24,200 in funds received in connection with the donation of the Public Art to the City to provide funding to the Art in Public Places Trust Fund for maintenance of the Public Art.

**Section 3. Oversight.** The Cultural Council of Greater Jacksonville, Inc. shall be responsible for the maintenance of the Public Art.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
