The improvements would transform the existing stadium into a first class, state-of-the-art venue designed to have a minumum useful live of thirty (30) years from the first home game played in the renovated stadium, and to enable it to continue to serve as the home stadium of the Jaguars, collegiate football egames, concerts, other sporting events, civic events and other significant events, and to incraese tourism and strengthn the local hospitality industry for the benefit of the City and the community.


