1 graduated from Roberts Wesleyan College in 1995 with a Bachelor of 2 Science in Biology, earned his naval aviator wings in 2001, and 3 completed initial helicopter training in 2002, who currently serves 4 as the Executive Officer of NAS JAX, will relive Capt. DeWindt in 5 command effective August 14, 2025; now therefore
