

Business Impact Estimate

Proposed ordinance's title/reference:

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS PROCESS; AMENDING SECTIONS 118.803 (GRANTS ADMINISTRATOR; RESPONSIBILITIES) AND 118.808 (FUNDING ALLOCATIONS BY THE PSG COUNCIL; GRANT AWARD LIMITATIONS), PART 8 (PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO UPDATE THE GRANTS ADMINISTRATOR AND GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION RESPONSIBILITIES AND ESTABLISH A DEADLINE FOR AGREEMENTS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

1. Summary of the proposed ordinance (must include a statement of the public purpose, such as serving the public health, safety, morals, and welfare)

This proposed ordinance would update the Grants Administrator and Grants and Contract Compliance Division responsibilities and create a deadline for agreements. The public purpose of the ordinance would be to improve the PSG process.
