Council President's Designated Contingency to the Jacksonville Upward Mobility Program ("JUMP") Special Revenue Fund to provide additional funding for various programs and services aimed at training, educating and maintaining a sustainable local workforce.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide additional funding for a variety of programs and services aimed at training, educating and maintaining a sustainable local workforce by investing in youth and young adults. Funds set aside in the JUMP Special Revenue Fund are specifically intended to fund new and existing apprenticeship, pre-apprenticeship and workforce training programs consistent with the mission and goals for the program as outlined in Chapter 180 (Jacksonville Upward Mobility Program), Ordinance Code.

The Sixth Revised Schedule M reflects the funds appropriated herein.
