5 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER
6 DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO
7 EXECUTE AND DELIVER A LOCALLY-FUNDED AGREEMENT
8 (LUMP SUM) BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA
9 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") AND THE
10 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE PURSUANT TO WHICH THE CITY
11 AGREES TO PAY FDOT \$450,000 FOR CERTAIN ROADWAY
12 IMPROVEMENTS; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE
13 ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT
14 DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS;
15 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Authorization to Execute.** The Mayor, or her
19 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to
20 execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, that certain
21 Locally-Funded Agreement (Lump Sum) between the State of Florida
22 Department of Transportation ("FDOT") and the City of Jacksonville,
23 in substantially the same form as is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and
24 incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"). Pursuant
25 to the Agreement, the City of Jacksonville agrees to pay FDOT \$450,000
26 for the design and construction of certain roadway improvements on
27 St. Johns Avenue. These improvements include traffic calming elements
28 to the existing FDOT resurfacing of St. Johns Avenue. Funding for
29 these improvements is included within the City's 5-year Capital
30 Improvement Plan with funding appropriations in fiscal years 2022-
31 2023 and 2023-2024 and is contingent upon City Council approval.
