Type of Action: Approve and authorize the Mayor and Sheriff to execute and deliver an agreement

Bill Summary: This ordinance approves and authorizes the Mayor, the Sheriff of Duval County, and the Corporation Secretary to execute and deliver an agreement regarding traffic control jurisdiction between the City and Montevilla at Bartram Lakes Association, Inc. (MBLA), pursuant to Section 316.006, *Florida Statutes*, which authorizes JSO to exercise municipal traffic control jurisdiction over the private and/or limited access roads within the boundaries of Montevilla at Bartram Lakes. The ordinance also authorizes JSO to enforce the 30-mile-per-hour speed limit on private roads within Montevilla at Bartram Lakes.

Background Information: MBLA has requested JSO to perform traffic control services on private and/or limited access roads within the boundaries of Montevilla at Bartram Lakes, located at the intersection of Bartram Park Boulevard and Vittoria Drive. MBLA's Board of Directors voted on July 29, 2026, to allow JSO to enter the Montevilla at Bartram Lakes property to exercise and perform such traffic control jurisdiction and approved entering into an agreement with the City and JSO providing the terms and conditions for these services.

Policy Impact Area: JSO, traffic control

Fiscal Impact: No cost to the City.
