7 **ORDINANCE 2021-182-E**

8 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 118 (CITY  
9 GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE; ESTABLISHING THE  
10 2021-2022 CATEGORIES OF MOST VULNERABLE  
11 PERSONS AND NEEDS FOR PUBLIC SERVICE GRANT  
12 APPROPRIATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 **WHEREAS**, the Public Service Grant Council met on February 22,  
15 2021 to approve the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Most Vulnerable Persons  
16 and Needs, a copy of the minutes of said meeting are attached  
17 hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev  
18 Minutes, April 19, 2021 - NCSPHS"; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the City Council through this ordinance is hereby  
20 establishing the Most Vulnerable Persons and Needs for the 2021-  
21 2022 Fiscal Year; now therefore

22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Categories of Most Vulnerable Persons and**  
24 **Needs Established.** Pursuant to Section 118.804, (Categories of  
25 Most Vulnerable Persons and Needs), *Ordinance Code*, the following  
26 categories of Most Vulnerable Persons and Needs, as recommended by  
27 the Public Service Grant Council in the letter attached hereto as  
28 **Exhibit 2**, are hereby established for the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year:

29 **2021-2022 Categories of Most Vulnerable Persons and Needs**

30 **1. Acute.** The percentage of available funding allocated to  
31 this category shall be 35%.

1           **2. Prevention.** The percentage of available funding allocated  
2 to this category shall be 40%.

3           **3. Self-Sufficiency.** The percentage of available funding  
4 allocated to this category shall be 25%.

5           Detailed definitions of each of the categories of Most  
6 Vulnerable Persons and Needs are set forth in **Exhibit 3.**

7           **Section 2. Public Service Grants to Serve Categories of**  
8 **Most Vulnerable Persons and Needs.** Public Service Grants made by  
9 City Council shall be used to exclusively serve the categories of  
10 Most Vulnerable Persons and Needs. Where a category contains more  
11 funding than applied for, then the excess funding for that  
12 population may be applied to a category that contains less funding  
13 than applied for. Where more than one category has fewer funds than  
14 applied for, then the excess funding shall be divided among the  
15 underfunded categories on a percentage basis where the total amount  
16 underfunded in all underfunded categories is the denominator and  
17 the amount underfunded in any one category is the numerator.

18           **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
20 without the Mayor's signature.
