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ORDINANCE 2024-690

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES, OR DESIGNEE, TO APPLY TO THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES (FDACS) FOR A GRANT TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE RENOVATION OF THE JACKSONVILLE CANNING CENTER LOCATED AT 2525 COMMONWEALTH AVENUE ("PROJECT"); AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES, OR HIS DESIGNEE, EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY ALL GRANT AND FUNDING AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY AND FDACS RELATED TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES; REQUESTING ONE-CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Canning Center located at 2525 Commonwealth Avenue (the "Canning Center") has a long-established history of serving those in need, including historically to inmates and depression-era families, and most recently to nonprofit organizations and volunteers, churches, school children, seniors, and cottage food entrepreneurs, and providing a space to learn, prepare, and preserve garden produce and innovate with cottage foods; and

WHEREAS, the Canning Center is a part of the University of Florida/Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences (UF/IFAS) Extension Duval County agricultural complex, including the office on N. McDuff Avenue and the Urban Gardens on Superior Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville ("City") desires to renovate the Canning Center (the "Project") in collaboration with the UF/IFAS Extension, in order to expand and modernize its services to the community; and

WHEREAS, in Ordinance 2023-349-E, the City Council approved \$500,000 in funding for the Project which funds will complete the first phase of the Project and bring the electrical, mechanical, and plumbing up to code; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue with additional Project renovations which would include the development of kitchenettes/cooking studios, modern canning stations, and a cottage food classroom, to provide citizens with rental and educational opportunities for food preparation, preservation, and cottage food entrepreneurship; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to establish the Canning Center as a qualified agriculture education and promotion facility to qualify for additional funding for the Project by the State of Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS) pursuant to Section 288.1175, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Canning Center serves a public purpose and the Project will greatly enhance the City and otherwise promote and further the municipal purposes of the City; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals above are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Director of Parks, Recreation and Community Services, or his designee, is hereby authorized to apply for grant funding for the Project with the FDACS in substantially the same form as the application attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference, and to execute and deliver on behalf of the

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City all grant and funding agreements related to the Project between the City and the FDACS, as well as any other documents related to such grants and funding.

Section 3. Oversight. The Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services shall oversee the Project and the grant described herein.

Section 4. Requesting One-Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One-cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is to comply with the requirements of the grant in a timely manner in order to apply by the deadline to receive funding for the Project.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
