5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$35,000.00 FROM THE  
6 STATE OF FLORIDA, DIVISION OF HISTORICAL  
7 RESOURCES TO HIRE A HISTORIC PRESERVATION  
8 CONSULTANT TO MAP THE OLD CITY CEMETERY, AS  
9 INITIATED BY B.T. 20-015; APPROVING AND  
10 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND  
11 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER  
12 THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF FLORIDA,  
13 DEPARTMENT OF STATE AND CITY OF JACKSONVILLE;  
14 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PLANNING AND  
15 DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN  
16 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
20 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
21 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
22 the accounts listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) Explanation of appropriation:

30 The funding above is a grant award from the State of

1 Florida, Division of Historical Resources for a Small  
2 Matching Grant for the project entitled "Old City  
3 Cemetery Mapping Project." The City is a Certified Local  
4 Government and is not required to match the funds.

5 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
6 Section 1 is to provide funds to hire a historic preservation  
7 consultant to map the Old City Cemetery (the "Project"). The  
8 Project involves mapping each gravesite with GPS equipment and  
9 software, recording additional information on the grave markers and  
10 linking it to the GPS location, and compiling all recorded GPS  
11 locations and information into a GIS data layer that will be  
12 available on the City's website.

13 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby  
14 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary  
15 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the Agreement between  
16 the State of Florida, Department of State and City of Jacksonville,  
17 a copy of which has been placed **ON FILE** with the Office of  
18 Legislative Services.

19 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Planning and Development  
20 Department shall oversee the project described herein.

21 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
23 without the Mayor's signature.
