6 FROM GENERAL FUND/ GENERAL SERVICES DISTRICT  
7 SPECIAL EVENTS TO GENERAL FUND/ GENERAL SERVICES  
8 DISTRICT EQUAL BUSINESS OPPORTUNITY OFFICE TO  
9 PROVIDE FUNDING FOR AN UPDATED MULTI-  
10 JURISDICTIONAL DISPARITY STUDY; PROVIDING FOR  
11 PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS;  
12 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PROCUREMENT  
13 DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,  
17 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
18 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)

26 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation**

27 The funds above are being appropriated from General  
28 Fund/General Services District Special Events funds for  
29 the costs associated with updating the Jacksonville Multi-  
30 Jurisdictional Disparity Study as originally prepared by  
31 Mason Tillman Associated, Ltd.

1           **Section 2.           Purpose.**    The purpose of the appropriation in  
2 Section 1 is to provide funding for an updated comprehensive disparity  
3 study. The original disparity study was performed by Mason Tillman  
4 Associates, Ltd, in 2013. The JSEB Special Committee has made  
5 recommendations in Ordinance 2021-117, currently pending, to update  
6 the 2013 study.

7           **Section 3.           Carryover.**   The funds appropriated in this  
8 ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2021-  
9 2022.

10          **Section 4.           Oversight Department.** The Procurement Division  
11 of the Finance and Administration Department shall select a consultant  
12 to provide the updated disparity study pursuant to the provisions of  
13 Chapter, 126, *Ordinance Code*, and shall oversee the completion of the  
14 updated study.

15          **Section 5.           Effective Date.**   This ordinance shall become  
16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
17 without the Mayor's signature.
