8 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$947,000 CONSISTING OF 9 \$400,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN AND FAMILIES, OFFICE OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE 10 AND MENTAL HEALTH ("DCF"), A KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE 11 ("KHA") CASH MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$85,000 FROM THE 12 13 KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE FUND, AND AN IN-KIND CONTRIBUTION OF \$462,000 CONSISTING OF SECURITY SERVICES PROVIDED 14 BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AT THE JUVENILE 15 16 ASSESSMENT CENTER, FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF A CRIMINAL JUSTICE, MENTAL HEALTH, AND 17 SUBSTANCE ABUSE REINVESTMENT GRANT PROGRAM ("CJMHSA PROGRAM"), FOR 18 THE FIRST YEAR OF THE THREE (3) YEAR GRANT TERM 19 20 BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2025 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2028, AS 21 INITIATED BY B.T. 25-063; AMENDING THE FOURTH 22 REVISED SCHEDULE M TO ORDINANCE 2024-511-E; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.108(G), (EXEMPTIONS 23 FROM COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION), PART 1 (GENERAL 24 25 REGULATIONS; ETHICS AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT 26 CODE), 27 ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH MANAGED ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC. FOR THE CJMHSA 2.8 PROGRAM; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR 29 30 HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR 31 THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE,

TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A CONTRACT WITH MANAGED ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE CJMHSA PROGRAM; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 77.111(A) (PROVIDER CONTRACTS), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXEMPT THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY MANAGED ACCESS TO CHILD HEALTH, INC. FROM COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: **Section 1.** Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

23 Explanation of Appropriation: (C) 24 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$400,000 25 in grant funds from the Florida Department of Children and 26 Families, Office of Substance Abuse and Mental Health for 27 implementation of a Criminal Justice, Mental Health, and Substance Abuse Reinvestment Grant Program ("CJMHSA 28 29 Program"), an \$85,000 cash match from the Kids Hope Alliance ("KHA") Fund, and an in-kind contribution of 30 \$462,000 consisting of security services provided by the 31

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Jacksonville Sheriff's Office at the Juvenile Assessment Center for the first year of the grant. The overall grant term is three (3) years, with the first year beginning April 1, 2025 and ending March 31, 2026.

5 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 6 Section 1 is to provide funding for the first year of a CJMHSA Program 7 for the period beginning April 1, 2025 and ending March 31, 2026, and to procure the professional services of Managed Access to Child 8 9 Health, Inc., to implement and carry out the CJMHSA Program. The 10 CJMHSA Program is to improve care coordination services for juvenile justice youth with indicators for mental health, substance use, and/or 11 trauma, and to expand the diversion continuum of community-based 12 resources to reduce the number of youth entering high levels of care. 13 This award is subject to the terms and conditions outlined in Contract 14 (CSFA Number 60.115) between the State of Florida, 15 No. LH881 Department of Children and Families and the City of Jacksonville, 16 which has been placed **On File** with the Legislative Services Division 17 and incorporated herein by this reference. 18

Section 3. Amending Fourth Revised Schedule M to Ordinance 20 2024-511-E. The Kids Hope Alliance fiscal year 2024-2025 budget 21 approved by Ordinance 2024-511-E is hereby amended by substituting 22 in the place of the Fourth Revised Schedule M, the Fifth Revised 23 Schedule M, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised 24 Exhibit 2, 5th Rev Sched M, May 5, 2025 - NCSPHS" and incorporated 25 herein by this reference, to reflect the funds appropriated herein.

Section 4. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.108(g), Ordinance Code. KHA is hereby authorized to directly procure the professional services of Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. for the implementation and administration of the CJMHSA Program in compliance with the grant described in Section 2 above. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g) (Exemptions from competitive solicitation), Part 1

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(General Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the services to be provided are being approved via authorizing legislation pursuant to this Ordinance. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. 8 The 9 Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary, and/or the 10 Chief Executive Officer of KHA, are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a contract between KHA and Managed Access to Child Health, 11 Inc. pursuant to which Managed Access to Child Health, Inc. will 12 provide professional services necessary for local implementation and 13 administration of the CJMHSA Program in compliance with the grant 14 described in Section 2. 15

Section 6. Waiving the Requirements of Section 77.111(a), 16 Ordinance Code. The City hereby waives the requirements of Section 17 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), 18 19 Ordinance Code, with respect to the contract with Managed Access to 20 Child Health, Inc. approved and authorized in Section 5 of this Ordinance. Section 77.111(a), Ordinance Code, requires contracts for 21 22 children's services provided by third parties to be competitively 23 procured by KHA via an evaluated bid process. This waiver is needed 24 in order to allow KHA to directly contract with Managed Access to 25 Child Health, Inc. to provide the CJMHSA Program services described 26 in the grant described in Section 2.

27 Section 7. Oversight Department. The Kids Hope Alliance 28 shall oversee administration of the grant and the CJMHSA Program.

29 Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 30 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 31 without the Mayor's signature.
