ORDINANCE 2025-139-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$152,362 FROM A GENERAL FUND OPERATING SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 COMMUNITY STUDY - OTHER PROFESSIONAL SERVICES ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO ENGAGE A CONSULTANT TO BRING TOGETHER REPRESENTATIVES FROM VARIOUS HOMEOWNER AND NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATIONS WITHIN COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 WITH A GOAL OF CREATING AN ENTITY AND/OR PLAN THAT DRAWS CONSENSUS AND ARTICULATES A VISION FOR COUNCIL DISTRICT 6; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$152,362 from a General Fund Operating Special Council Contingency account to the Council District 6 Community Study - Other Professional Services account to provide funding to engage a consultant to coordinate with various homeowner and neighborhood associations to create an entity and/or plan that can organize and articulate a vision for Council District 6 with a focus on preservation and beautification.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds to engage a consultant to bring together representatives from various homeowner and neighborhood associations within Council District 6 with a goal of creating an entity and/or plan that draws consensus and articulates a vision for Council District 6 with a focus on the priorities of preservation and beautification.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

Section 4. Oversight Department. The Neighborhoods Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
