ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING 5 AN THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION 6 7 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON 8 BEHALF OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY"), AN 9 AMENDMENT ONE TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT ("AGREEMENT") BETWEEN THE CITY AND ALLEGIS 10 GROUP, INC. ("COMPANY"), TO AMEND THE DEFINITION 11 OF THE PROJECT PARCEL THEREIN TO RECOGNIZE NEW 12 13 OFFICE SPACE BEING UTILIZED BY THE COMPANY; AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS BY 14 THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF ECONOMIC 15 DEVELOPMENT ("OED"); PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY 16 THE OED; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 17

WHEREAS, Allegis Group, Inc. (the "Company") and the City have previously entered into that certain Economic Development Agreement dated July 29, 2022 (the "Agreement"), pursuant to which the Company has committed to create 500 permanent full-time equivalent new jobs in Jacksonville with an average salary, exclusive of benefits, of \$53,000 per annum by December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement is in full force and effect in accordance with its terms and the Company is in compliance therewith, however the Company has relocated a portion of its operations to different locations within the City, and the parties wish to amend the definition of the Project Parcel in the Agreement to reflect the same; now therefore,

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

1 Section 1. Amendment One to Economic Development Agreement 2 Approved. The Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary 3 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of 4 the City, the Amendment One to Economic Development Agreement 5 ("Amendment One") substantially in the form placed attached hereto 6 as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference.

7 Amendment One may include such additions, deletions, and changes 8 as may be reasonable, necessary, and incidental for carrying out the 9 purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor or her designee, 10 with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Amendment One by the Mayor or her designee. No modification of 11 the Amendment One may increase the financial obligations or the 12 13 liability of the City and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval 14 of the General Counsel or his or her designee and all other 15 appropriate action required by law. "Technical" is herein defined as 16 including, but not limited to, changes in legal descriptions and 17 surveys, descriptions of infrastructure improvements and/or any road 18 19 project, ingress and egress, easements and rights of way, performance schedules (provided that no performance schedule may be extended for 20 21 more than one year without City Council approval), design standards, 22 access and site plans which have no financial impact.

23 Section 2. Oversight Department. The Office of Economic
24 Development shall oversee the Project described herein.

25 Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 27 without the Mayor's signature.
