The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has approved the City of Jacksonville/Jacksonville Sheriff's Office's (COJ/JSO) application for financial assistance submitted under the Subgrant for National Priority Safety Program in the amount of \$66,000. These funds will be used to perform overtime operations to increase safety belt use, and will cover expenses for overtime and benefits (medicare tax) for officers.

This legislation is necessary to appropriate the grant award from the Florida Department of Transportation with no local match for the grant period of October 1, 2023 to September 30, 2024.
