Liaisons. There shall be four permanent liaisons present at Board meetings which shall include the State Attorney (or Chief Assistant State Attorney), the Sheriff (or the Undersheriff), the Public Defender (or Chief Assistant Public Defender), and the Superintendent of Schools (or Assistant Superintendent). In addition, the Council President may annually designate assign a Council Member to serve as a liaison to the Board. The designated assigned Council Member and the State Attorney (or Chief Assistant State Attorney), the Sheriff (or the Undersheriff), the Public Defender (or Chief Assistant Public Defender), and the Superintendent of Schools (or Assistant Superintendent) shall not be considered voting members of the Board for Florida's Open Meetings Law purposes.

Sec. 116.1402. - Special Committee on Group Health Benefits.

Pursuant to Chapter 33, Part 3, Ordinance Code, the Benefits Division of the Employee Services Department is responsible for ensuring the efficient and effective procurement of health and life insurance for the benefit of the City and its employees and retirees. To share information with plan participants about benefits and options included in the Group Health Plan, the Benefits Division shall meet semiannually with a Special Committee on Group Health Benefits which shall be composed of the following:

- (a) The Director of Employee Services, or his/her designee;
- (b) The Director of the Finance Departmentand Administration, or his/her designee;
- (c) One Council Member, <u>designated</u> appointed by the Council President;
- (d) The Council Auditor, or his/her designee;
- (e) One member from each employee collective bargaining unit as designated by the respective unions;
- (g) One City retiree actively participating in the Group Health
 Plan as designated by Employee Services;

The Special Committee on Group Health Benefits shall convene only for the purpose of receiving a semiannual update from the Employee Services Department on the status and projection of the Group Health Plan. The Special Committee on Group Health Benefits shall not make any recommendations, provide advice, vote, nor engage in any decision-making regarding the Group Health Plan. Individual committee members are permitted to express their individual input regarding the Group Health Plan to the Employee Services Department. The Employee Services Department will keep the committee informed of major developments to the Group Health Plan for informational purposes only. It is the intent of the City of Jacksonville that the Special

Committee on Group Health Benefits only engage in informational-gathering activities and duties, and shall not be considered a board or commission for purposes of Florida's Open Meetings Law.

Section 6. Amending Section 94.103 (Membership; Terms; Composition), Chapter 94 (Tree Commission), Ordinance Code. Section 94.103 (Membership; Terms; Composition), Chapter 94 (Tree Commission), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 94 - TREE COMMISSION

* * *

Sec. 94.103. - Membership; Terms; Composition.

The Commission shall be composed of seven members selected as follows:

- (a) Membership
 - (1) One member of the Council <u>appointed</u> designated by the Council President.
 - (2) The Director of the Public Works Department, or his or her designee.
 - (3) Three members of the general public appointed by the Council.
 - (4) Two members of the general public appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council.

* * *

Section 7. Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and division "tables of contents" consistent with the changes set forth herein. Such editorial changes and any others necessary to make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein, and changes to the Ordinance Code shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
