8 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$128,160 FROM THE
9 SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND (THE "FUND")
10 FOR A DONATION TO I.M. SULZBACHER CENTER FOR THE
11 HOMELESS, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,000 IN
12 ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 932.7055(5), FLORIDA
13 STATUTES, TO SUPPORT DRUG TREATMENT, DRUG ABUSE
14 EDUCATION, DRUG PREVENTION, CRIME PREVENTION,
15 SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS, AND SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER
16 PROGRAM(S), TRANSFERRING \$12,500 FROM THE FUND
17 TO THE TEEN DRIVER SPECIAL REVENUE FUND FOR THE
18 TEEN DRIVER CHALLENGE PROGRAM, IN ACCORDANCE
19 WITH SECTION 111.365, *ORDINANCE CODE*,
20 TRANSFERRING \$7,500 FROM THE FUND TO THE POLICE
21 EXPLORERS TRUST FUND FOR THE JACKSONVILLE
22 SHERIFF'S POLICE EXPLORER POST, AND \$66,160 FROM
23 THE FUND TO REIMBURSE THE GENERAL FUND FOR
24 FORFEITURE RELATED EXPENDITURES IN ACCORDANCE
25 WITH SECTION 932.7055(4)(C), FLORIDA STATUTES;
26 PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; APPROVING AND
27 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE
28 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON
29 BEHALF OF THE CITY, A MISCELLANEOUS
30 APPROPRIATIONS AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF

JACKSONVILLE AND I.M. SULZBACHER CENTER FOR THE HOMELESS, INC.; WAIVING SECTION 110.112, (ADVANCE OF CITY FUNDS; PROHIBITION AGAINST), PART 1 (THE CITY TREASURY), CHAPTER 110 (CITY TREASURY), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR ADVANCE PAYMENT BY THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$128,160 from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund (the "Fund") for a donation to I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc., and various transfers of Fund dollars to other City funds in accordance with the *Ordinance Code* and Section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, as more specifically outlined herein.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide a donation to I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the

1 Homeless, Inc. in the amount of \$42,000 for the Chronically Homeless
2 Offender Program. This allocation supports programs and services
3 aimed at drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime
4 prevention, safe neighborhood, and/or school resource officer
5 programs for the citizens of the City of Jacksonville, Duval County,
6 Florida. A Certification from the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office that
7 this appropriation from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund
8 complies with Section 932.7055(5), Florida Statutes, is attached
9 hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

10 In addition to the above, this appropriation includes a transfer
11 of \$12,500 from the Fund to the Teen Driver Special Revenue Fund for
12 the Teen Driver Challenge Program in accordance with Section 111.365,
13 *Ordinance Code*, a transfer of \$7,500 from the Fund to the Police
14 Explorers Trust Fund for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Police
15 Explorer Post, in accordance with Section 111.340, *Ordinance Code*,
16 and \$66,160 from the Fund to reimburse the General Fund for
17 forfeiture-related expenditures in accordance with Section
18 932.7055(4)(c), Florida Statutes.

19 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization.** There is hereby
20 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
21 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of
22 the City, the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City
23 of Jacksonville and I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc.
24 (the "Agreement") in substantially the same form as has been placed
25 **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

26 **Section 4. Waiving Section 110.112, Ordinance Code.**
27 Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1
28 (The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), *Ordinance Code*, is
29 hereby waived to allow for advance payment as described in the
30 Agreement.

31 **Section 5. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office

1 shall oversee the Agreement described herein.

2 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
3 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
4 without the Mayor's signature.
