6 LOCAL MATCH, FROM FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW
7 ENFORCEMENT FOR THE NATION CRIME STATISTICS
8 EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 30, 2020,
9 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2021, AS INITIATED BY B.T.
10 20-107; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR
11 HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO
12 EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY THE
13 CERTIFICATE OF SUBAWARD AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF
14 FEDERAL FUNDING ASSISTANCE BETWEEN THE FLORIDA
15 DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AND THE CITY OF
16 JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY JSO;
17 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
22 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
23 listed in subsection (b):

30 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

31 The funding above is from the Florida Department of Law

1 Enforcement for the Nation Crime Statistics Exchange
2 Program for the period April 30, 2020, through September
3 30,2021. No local match is required.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
5 Section 1 is to assist the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO) with
6 meeting the January 2021 deadline to submit crime data to the Florida
7 Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) and, subsequently, to the FBI.The
8 project includes analysis, the creation of the required data elements,
9 and test submissions to FDLE. This one-time transition does not
10 warrant additional full-time positions; thus, JSO is proposing the
11 use of a procurement contract for temporary staff augmentation. Under
12 the procurement contract, two individuals will perform work over a
13 nine month period to: 1) conduct an analysis; 2) extract/build the
14 necessary data elements into the Records Management System (RMS);
15 and, 3)complete test submissions.

16 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
17 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
18 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of
19 the City the Certificate of Subaward and the Acceptance of Federal
20 Funding Assistance between the City and FDLE, in substantially the
21 same forms attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by
22 this reference.

23 **Section 4. Oversight.** JSO shall oversee the Program.

24 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
25 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
26 without the Mayor's signature.
