15 REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE;

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
20 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
22 listed in subsection (b):

1 Activity to provide meals to employees working during the
2 Primary Election Day in August, 2024.

3 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
4 Section 1 is to provide funding for the provision of meals to the
5 Supervisor of Elections Office employees working during the Primary
6 Election Day in August, 2024. Employees will be working double shifts
7 commencing at 6:00 a.m. until 12:00 a.m., or later, and will not be
8 able to leave the facility to get meals.

9 **Section 3. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**
10 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this
11 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that there
12 is an immediate need for the funds to provide meals for the essential
13 employees of the Supervisor of Elections Office during the extended
14 hours required on Election Day.

15 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
17 without the Mayor's signature.
