AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$3,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING - SEEL ELECTIONS - OTHER GENERAL GOVERNMENTAL - OTHER OPERATING SUPPLIES ACCOUNT (552160) TO THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING - SEEL ELECTIONS - OTHER GENERAL GOVERNMENTAL -FOOD ACCOUNT (552060) TO PROVIDE MEALS TO EMPLOYEES WORKING DURING THE PRIMARY ELECTION DAY IN AUGUST 2024, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-131; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 2. Purpose.
