Type of Action: Amending Ordinance Code

Bill Summary: This legislation reduces the number of board members necessary for a quorum on the Safety and Crime Reduction Commission. This measurement of quorum excludes vacant seats, and measures quorum by a majority of the current membership. A vacancy shall not impair the ability of a majority of the remaining members to execute all the duties and perform all the functions of the Commission.

Background Information: Previously eleven voting members (a majority of the full number of commission members) were needed to constitute a quorum.
