5 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS;
6 APPROPRIATING \$9,000,000 FROM A DESIGNATED
7 SPECIAL COUNCIL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FOR PUBLIC
8 SERVICE GRANTS; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY
9 THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF
10 THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION;
11 WAIVING THE CONFLICTING PROVISION OF SECTION
12 118.802 (ANNUAL LUMP SUM APPROPRIATION FOR
13 PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS), PART 8 (PUBLIC SERVICE
14 GRANTS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), *ORDINANCE*
15 *CODE*, TO APPROVE THE LUMP SUM APPROPRIATION FOR
16 PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS BY SEPARATE LEGISLATION
17 FROM THE ANNUAL BUDGET ORDINANCE; PROVIDING AN
18 EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,
22 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
23 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
24 listed in subsection (b):

1 appropriation from the designated Council Contingency
2 account for Public Service Grants.

3 **Section 2. Purpose.** The Public Service Grant appropriation
4 shall be allocated to the Acute, Prevention and Diversion, and Self-
5 Sufficiency and Stability categories of Most Vulnerable Persons and
6 Needs as outlined in **Exhibit 2** and shall be used only for the purpose
7 of the listed Public Service Grant Appropriations and may not be
8 transferred or reallocated for any other utilization within the
9 respective department. Public Service Grants are subject to the
10 provisions of Chapter 118, *Ordinance Code*. The appropriations made
11 herein shall be awarded as grants-in-aid to miscellaneous agencies
12 and shall not require additional legislation for distribution of
13 funds. Pursuant to Section 118.808, *Ordinance Code*, the Public Service
14 Grant Council shall forward a complete list of the Public Service
15 Grants recipients and funding allocation to the Council Auditor's
16 Office, the Office of the Mayor, the City Council, and the Director
17 of the Finance and Administration Department.

18 **Section 3. Oversight Department.** The Grants and Contract
19 Compliance Division of the Finance and Administration Department
20 shall oversee the grants described herein.

21 **Section 4. Waiving Conflicting Provision of Section**
22 **118.802, Ordinance Code.** The conflicting provision of Section 118.802
23 (Annual Lump Sum Appropriation for Public Service Grants), Part 8
24 (Public Service Grants), Chapter 118 (City Grants), *Ordinance Code*,
25 referring to "the annual budget ordinance" is hereby waived. Waiver
26 of Section 118.802, *Ordinance Code*, is necessary because the Public
27 Service Grant lump sum appropriation for the 2023-2024 annual budget
28 will be considered by Council by this Ordinance 2023-509 and not in
29 the annual budget Ordinance 2023-504.

30 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
31 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective

1 without the Mayor's signature.
