

**Exhibit 2**Terms established by the Council Rate Review Process:

1. The Monthly Base Rate Component was adjusted on October 1, 2018 to \$10.53 and continued at such rate through September 30, 2019. Commencing October 1, 2019, the Monthly Base Rate Component shall be \$10.34, and shall be adjusted thereafter, if necessary, pursuant to the Agreement.

2. The fuel cap numbers shall be 337,983 gallons for FY 2019/2020, 341,427 gallons for FY 2020/2021 and 344,906 gallons for FY 2021/2022.

3. Effective October 1, 2019, 444 Residential Premises will be deducted from the September 30, 2019 premise count to determine the beginning number for Service Area I. The ending number of Residential Premises per the September 30, 2019 statement was 73,864.

4. As disposal sites change, travel times may change and compensation may increase or decrease as a result. The City and Contractor agree that the hourly rate per route is deemed to be \$116.00 from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020. Thereafter, the hourly rate per route shall be adjusted in accordance with the Agreement.

5. If and when the Mayor declares a Storm Emergency event, the City agrees to pay Contractor \$102.00 per ton for collection of Storm Yard Waste, as stipulated and adjusted pursuant to the Agreement.
