Bill Summary: This bill appoints Roderick E. Myrick to the Jacksonville Small and Emerging Business ("JSEB") Monitoring Committee, as a JSEB Contractor, filling a seat formerly held by Antoinette D. Meskel, for a partial term expiring April 30, 2025, followed by a first full term expiring April 30, 2028.

Background Information: The JSEB Monitoring Committee is established pursuant to Section 126.607, *Ordinance Code*, and charged with reviewing the status and achievements of the JSEB Program Goals.

Section 126.607 (b), *Ordinance Code*, provides that there are seven members, four of whom are appointed by City Council, with one that is a JSEB contractor.

Mr. Myrick holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Florida in civil engineering. He is president and senior project engineer at AE Engineering, a certified JSEB vendor. Mr. Myrick resides in Duval County in council district 2.
