AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 CITY GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE BOSELLI FOUNDATION, INC. ("BOSELLI") FOR THE TEACHER FELLOWSHIP AND MENTORING PROGRAMS AS ORIGINALLY AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE 2024-839-E, SUBJECT TO A REVISED TERM SHEET AND BUDGET AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2024-839-E, the City Council appropriated \$500,000 to The Boselli Foundation, Inc. ("Boselli") to support the Teacher Fellowship and Mentoring Programs (the "Program(s)") in fiscal year 2024-2025; and

WHEREAS, Boselli has requested certain adjustments to the approved Term Sheet and Budget for the Programs to reallocate City funds to line-items that better support the needs of each Program; and

WHEREAS, because these adjustments amount to more than 10% of the affected line-items, City Council approval of the changes is required; now therefore BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

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Section 1. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 City Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and The Boselli Foundation, Inc. for the Programs, originally authorized by Ordinance 2024-839-E, to extend the grant term to expire on April 30, 2026, subject to the revised Term Sheet and Budget attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

The Teacher Fellowship Program is a year-long program that provides qualified teachers in kindergarten through 12th grade classrooms with professional learning and skills development opportunities. The Mentoring Program fosters leadership development for young men by promoting self-worth, communication skills and the ability to lead oneself and others through increased self-awareness. The City funds were originally appropriated to support various administrative costs for Boselli to operate the Programs. The revised Term Sheet and Budget reflect a reallocation of funds from certain salaries and benefits for positions within the Programs as well as funds allocated for certain occupancy expenses and direct client expenses and redirects those funds to pay the costs for dental and other benefits for positions supporting the Programs and other occupancy expenses, including insurance, postage, professional fees

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Section 3. Oversight. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the project described herein.
