This will follow up our first correspondence to you dated March 14, 2024 wherein we informed you of a request for a street name change on Confederate Street in which you have CTSC Small Cell equipment located. While not technically a property owner, a street name change at the request of a citizen or citizens group requires the agreement of 75% of the owners of property whose property has an assigned address from the street name that is proposed to be changed. According to our data, you have CTSC Small Cell equipment addressed from Confederate Street. The proposed street name change seeks to rename Confederate Street, which extends from Hubbard Street to Market Street North then extending from Market Street North to Liberty Street North, to **Frazier Place**. To date, the Addressing Section staff has not received a response from you regarding this street name change.
