The funding above is from a grant of \$9,500,000.00 from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). This funding will reimburse \$9,500,000.00 of the City's costs in connection with the design, construction, and construction engineering and inspection of the University Boulevard Complete Streets Project ("Project").

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for the Project. Complete streets is a transportation philosophy that calls for designing and building streets that are optimal for all road users regardless of age, ability, income, race, ethnicity, or chosen mode of travel. The Project will transform 6,500 feet of University Boulevard by milling and resurfacing with potential improvements to include reduced travel lane widths, construction of buffer bike lanes, mid-block crossings, reconfiguration of the Burdette/Lake Lucina intersection, high-emphasis crosswalks, and installation of a median where left turning movements are not compromised. The final project scope will be determined through stakeholder meetings and design development.

Section 3. Approval and authorization to execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Construction Reimbursement Agreement between FDOT and City of Jacksonville, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is

hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the Project, as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral could result
