A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING SEPTEMBER AS PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS MONTH; REQUESTING EMERGENCY INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING PASSAGE UPON AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in 2023, the American Cancer Society estimates there will be about 288,300 new cases and about 34,700 deaths from prostate cancer; and

WHEREAS, there is a higher survival rate upon early detection, so it is essential to increase awareness about the screening guidelines and symptoms of prostate cancer so that it can be treated as early as possible; and

WHEREAS, prostate cancer does not affect the population equally, with African American men, men over the age of 65, and men who have a family history of prostate cancer more likely to be diagnosed and to die from this disease; and

WHEREAS, while scientists endeavor to better understand prostate cancer and develop innovative treatments, it is imperative that individuals, government agencies, private businesses, nonprofit organizations, and other interested groups raise public awareness about early prostate cancer screening and prevention; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby recognizes September as Prostate Cancer Awareness Month, providing
