Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of John Trevanthan to the Homelessness Initiatives Commission, replacing Isaiah Oliver, for a partial initial term ending February 28, 2027.

Background Information: Chapter 89, *Ordinance Code* established the Homelessness Initiatives Commission as an advisory body of the City to assess the current unmet needs of Duval County's homeless and chronic unhoused populations and to make recommendations regarding programs, initiatives and services to be funded by the City's Homelessness Initiatives Special Revenue Fund.

Pursuant to Section 86.103 (a), *Ordinance Code*, four members of the general public shall be appointed by the Council President and confirmed by Council, and three members of the general public shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council. To the extent possible, each of the members of the general public should possess specialized knowledge about the needs of the homeless and chronic unhoused populations.

Mr. Trevanthan holds a bachelor's degree from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He is the Vice President of Enterprise Corporate Services for GuideWell Mutual Holding Corporation. Mr. Trevanthan resides in Duval County in council district 3.
