The appropriation above is grant funding, with no local match, from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement under the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) to purchase operating supplies for the PREA Inmate Education Initiative and to increase video surveillance at JSO

correctional facilities.

Section 2. Purpose.
